Opportunities for Respiratory Therapists in Simulation Education

As I reflect on my career as a respiratory therapist, I have had the opportunity to work with a diverse group of colleagues and friends, including fellow staff respiratory therapists, nurses, and physicians whom I encountered from the time I held my first job as a graduate respiratory therapist in a hospital, through my long career in respiratory therapy education.

I am now in a unique position with the University of Georgia. Currently, I am the Coordinator for the Simulation Center at the Augusta University/University of Georgia (AU/UGA) Medical Partnership located on the University of Georgia Health Science Campus in Athens, GA. The Partnership is a consortium between the University of Georgia and the Medical College of Georgia of Augusta University. This consortium has brought together the best instructional, clinical, and research resources of both universities to provide medical education in Athens. The UGA Health Science Campus is relatively new to the University of Georgia and was created 12 years ago when the University acquired a former US Naval Supply Corps School property in Athens. Plans for this new campus included an initial 40-student-per-year class of medical students to increase opportunities for medical education in the University System of Georgia while allowing for smaller class sizes. The Health Science Campus also houses undergraduate and graduate programs in public health and includes classrooms, research laboratories, student residences, administrative offices, dining services, and a daycare center.

Cohort sizes for the medical students were planned to increase first to 50 per year and then to our current maximum of 60 students per year. With this new location for the Partnership came a Simulation Center. While smaller in comparison to many larger medical college simulation centers, what started out as a 1-room simulation lab has now expanded to a five-bay simulation center that can accommodate our growing class size and the needs of the many clinical experiences the students are exposed to in medical education.

We currently have eight high-fidelity simulation manikins which include five adult patients, one pediatric patient, one infant, and one newborn. We use both Laerdal® and Gaumard® brands of simulators based on our specific needs for cases and scenarios. For example, we chose the Gaumard® simulator for the capability of OB/GYN exams and newborn delivery. The Control Room provides monitoring of all five simulation bays with audio and video recording that connects directly to the simulation bays.

Many simulation centers located in medical education also provide experiences for students in nursing, respiratory care, and other allied health programs. As respiratory therapists, we can bring a unique blend of experience and expertise to the field of simulation. Respiratory therapists are highly trained in the use of technically sophisticated equipment, such as non-invasive and invasive mechanical ventilators, airway devices, monitoring devices, and diagnostic instruments. With this experience and technical ability, we can bring another level of sophistication to simulation training. Not only can we easily learn the mechanics of high-fidelity manikins and the associated software, but we can apply our experience as caregivers to simulation scenarios. Furthermore, a respiratory care educator can bring knowledge of problem-based learning, clinical simulation scenarios, testing, and measurement to name only a few.



Opportunities for Respiratory Therapists in Simulation Education (cont.)

While my current position in simulation is primarily in an administrative support role, I have been allowed the unique opportunity to offer input on new simulation cases, participate in “pilot simulations” in the role of a medical student, and provide instruction on oxygen therapy and airway management in both the classroom and laboratory settings. While many of the simulation cases in medical education focus on a broader spectrum of care, I believe respiratory therapists, and especially respiratory therapy educators can advance the scope of training to include not only oxygen therapy and airway management but mechanical ventilation, critical care rotations, hemodynamic monitoring, non-invasive positive pressure ventilation, and other special diagnostic procedures. My involvement with the medical students has also provided an excellent opportunity for me to demonstrate what a respiratory therapist does in the clinical setting, and how the therapist can be a valuable resource as they begin their careers in medicine.

If you are looking for a change in your career path, or a chance to expand your opportunities, consider a position in a simulation center. This offers an excellent avenue for respiratory therapists to bring our clinical and educational knowledge to the simulation environment. Several options may be available to respiratory therapists to pursue an alternative career path while still supporting and contributing to the profession. Simulation centers typically have simulation coordinators who handle all the scheduling in the simulation center, ordering the appropriate equipment, interacting with the students as they attend encounters and curriculum planning. Simulation technicians prepare the patient rooms for every type of encounter in the labs which includes the use and training of high-fidelity simulation manikins, patient scenarios, laboratory exercises, moulage applications, and software support.

Respiratory therapists are also eligible to earn credentials in the field of simulation. This is an opportunity to receive formal recognition in specialized areas of simulation education and includes Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator® (CHSE®) and Certified Healthcare Simulation Operations Specialist® (CHSOS®). Advanced-level credentials are also available. With the growing field of simulation education, you may find a new direction for your career while maintaining your expertise as a respiratory therapist and combining it with simulation education and operations.

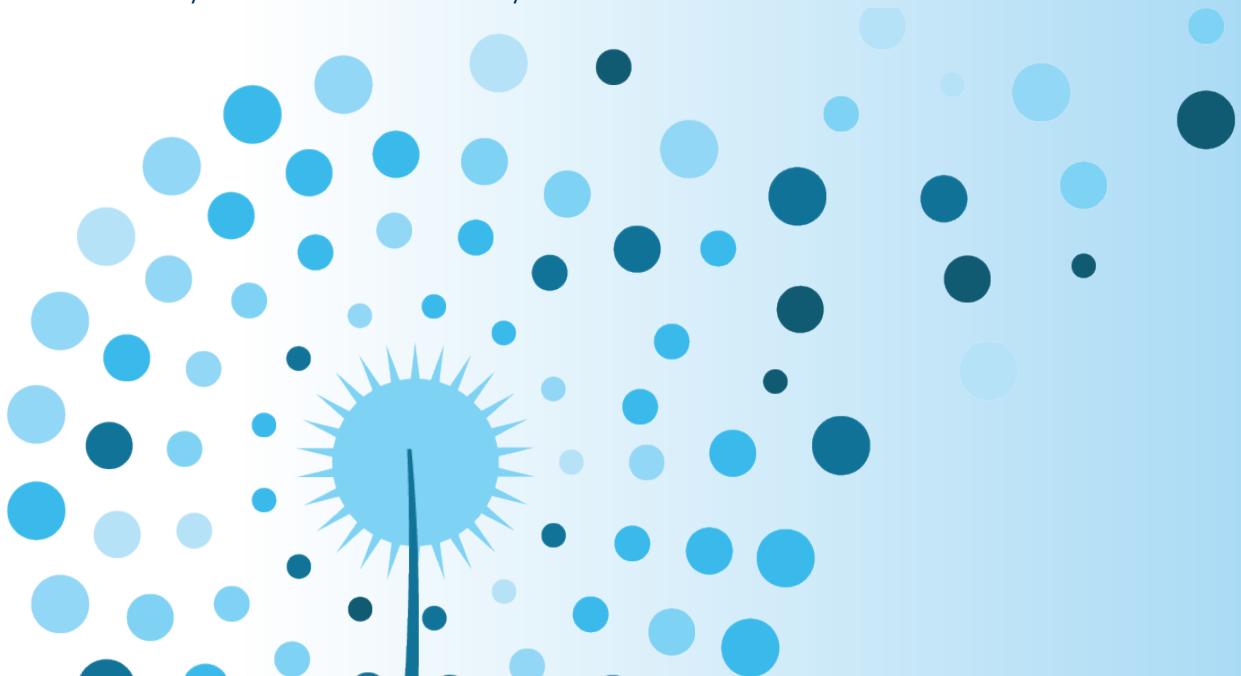

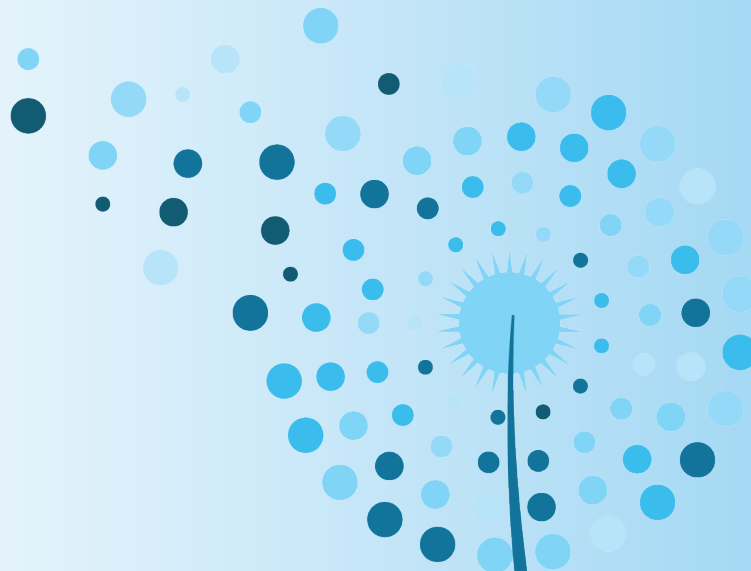
